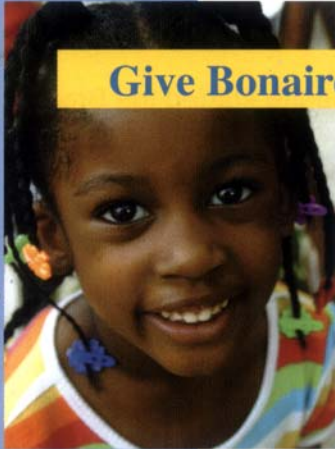


# Breakfast in Schools

- In August 2004, the Rotary Club of Bonaire started the Breakfast in Schools project.
- Each school day more than 250 children, who would otherwise go without breakfast, receive a sandwich, fresh fruit and milk. This simple meal helps curb hunger, allowing children to concentrate in school, and provides nutrition that their growing bodies need.
